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ABOUT THE COLLEGE: HISTORICAL NOTES

Kristu Jyoti College of Management & Technology (KJCMT) Chethipuzha came into being in the year 2002. It is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University and given tacit approval by All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi(AICTE). It accords the Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses such as MCA, M.Com Finance and Taxation, MA.HRM & MSc Psychology at the Postgraduate level and BBA, BCA, B.Com Computer Application, B.Com Finance and Taxation ,BSc Psychology, BSc Geology and B A English at the Undergraduate level. KJCMT that offers post-graduate programme in Computer Application was started in the year 2002.

B. Com with Computer Application were started in the year 2004. The College got affiliation from MG University in the year 2010 to start B.C.A and B.B.A courses. The MG University and Govt. of Kerala, given its NOC to start M. Com (Finance) and B. Com (Finance and Taxation) courses from 2011. The first batch of MCA was started in the year 2002. The Department of Psychology came into existence in the year 2014 with an eclectic vision. The Department of Geology was established in 2015 and offers B.Sc. Geology Program (Model 1), under affiliation to the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. The English Department of Kristu Jyoti College came into existence in the year 2015. The foundation stone of this building was laid by His Grace Geevarghese Mar Themothios, Bishop of Thiruvalla Diocese. Inauguration of the academics of the college was done by His Grace Mar Joseph Powathil on December 3, 2002. As a part of the expansion of the institution, the construction of a four storied building as an annexe to the college is in progress. The foundation stone of this building was laid by Rev. Fr. Thomas Choolaparambil CMI, Prior, S H Monastery, on May 4, 2006.

KJCMT is situated in a lush educational hub, surrounded by abundant greenery and picturesque surroundings in every direction. It is also well-connected digitally and infrastructure-wise from all sides. The college naturally possesses the capacity to cater to the diverse needs of its students.
