

## POLICY ON WATER CONSERVATION

The policy on water conservation aims at frugal use of water resources. Kristu Jyoti College of Management and Technology (KJCMT) follows a pragmatic water conservation policy throughout the campus.

## 1. Objectives

- Students and staff are expected to use water frugally, avoiding wastage of even a drop of water.
- They are advised to keep wash basin taps half open while using to avoid wastage of water.
- > Taps should be closed immediately after use.
- Potable water provided through water filters is to be used for drinking purpose only.
- Students are encouraged to bring bottled drinking water so as to conserve water.
- > If anybody is found misusing or wasting water, he/she will be fined.

## 2. Sources of Water

Potable water is drawn from wells and filtered drinking water is made available through five water coolers installed in different locations within the building. Water for the entire Kristu Group of institutions is drawn from an open well and bore well in premises of Placid Vidya Vihar Senior Secondary School-a sister institute of the college. Water for gardening is drawn from the pond located near Kristu Jyoti Auditorium. The water is directly pumped to roof top tanks over the college and other sister institutions.



3. Water Conservation Measure

A rain water harvesting unit with a capacity of 1,30,000 liters has been installed on northern side of Main Block. Water from roof top is collected through pipes, filtered and stored in circular shaped rain water harvesting unit. Water collected in this unit is to be used for gardening and construction purposes.
