Ultimately, these surveys help foster a positive learning environment and contribute to higher student retention and success rates. A thorough, well-structured questionnaire created with Google Forms, an online survey administration tool, served as the basis for the survey. and graduate programs took part in the poll in total. A five-point rating system was used to collect the answers to the questions. The next sections of the document provide an analysis of the survey results.

3. SUMMARY

The students are generally satisfied with the overall teaching-learning process of the institution; however, some suggestions for further improvement have been recommended. A summary of the findings of the survey is given below:

- * Approximately ninety-five percent of students have reported being satisfied with the faculty's level of preparedness for classes.
- Approximately ninety-one percent of all student feedback indicated that more than seventy percent of the curriculum for all programs has been covered in the classroom.
- Approximately ninety-three percent of students reported that their teachers are mostly effective in communicating and clarifying the ideas and concepts with clarity and efficiency.
- Around ninety-two percent of the students expressed that teachers are very much dedicated and duty bound.
- ❖ Over ninety-three percent of students believe that the internal assessment methods are generally fair.
- Over ninety-two percent of students stated that teachers often discuss their performance analysed through internal assessments and offer helpful tips for improvement.
- Around ninety-one percent of students acknowledged they are getting ample opportunities for internship, student exchange, field visits etc.
- Around ninety-one percent of the students expressed that their cognitive, social and emotional Fr. Dr. Joshy George challenges are successfully addressed through the teaching and mentoring process in the institution.

- Around ninety two percent of students observed that the institution takes keen interest and initiative towards promoting the multifaceted skills and talents of the students so as to contribute to their success in various careers as well as life in general.
- Around ninety one percent of the students responded that proper communication is given regarding expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes at the time of commencement of the course itself.
- Approximately ninety one percent of the students were of the opinion that the mentoring process is carried out effectively and the mentor performs follow up every time.
- Approximately ninety percent of the students registered positive responses regarding the performance of teachers in using examples and applications for illustration of concepts.
- Around ninety percent of the students agreed that teachers encourage them reasonably to identify and develop their strengths and provide them with the right level of challenges.
- Approximately ninety percent of the students responded that teachers usually help them to identify and rectify their weaknesses and support them to tide over the challenges with confidence.
- Over ninety one percent of the students opined positively regarding the institutional efforts to engage students in the quality review and monitoring process of the activities of the College.
- Approximately ninety two percent of students were satisfied with the student centric approach of the institution giving emphasis to participative learning, experiential learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

- Over ninety one percent of students were of the view that teachers take keen interest in enriching their life skills, soft skills and employability skills.
- Around ninety two percent of the students have given a positive response regarding the discipline maintained in the college, appreciating the organized and respectful atmosphere that supports a productive learning environment.
- Around ninety three percent of the students responded that there exists a positive relationship between teachers and students that fosters a supportive learning environment, enhances student engagement, and promotes academic and personal growth.
- Around eighty seven percent of the students expressed they are satisfied with the ambience of the college campus.
- Around ninety two percent of the students are satisfied with the classroom facilities of the college.
- Around ninety one percent of the students are satisfied with the office staff of the college.
